The following action was taken at the ASHP Commission on Credentialing meeting on March 4-6, 2011:

**VOTED**

To approve for reaccreditation the pharmacy technician training program at Pima Community College, Tucson, Arizona; further,

To grant accreditation for six years (2016); a midterm progress report will be requested in three years.

(Note: The Commission identified that areas of noncompliance 1, and partial compliance 2, 3, and 4 have been resolved to its satisfaction and no further information needs to be provided in these areas on the next progress report; all other areas of partial compliance should be addressed in the midterm progress report.)

The Commission arrived at its decision based on a thorough review of the progress report submitted by your institution. Continued accreditation is granted subject to the provisions set forth in the *ASHP Regulations on Accreditation of Pharmacy Technician Training Programs*.

The ASHP Board of Directors reviewed and accepted the Commission on Credentialing actions on April 15, 2011.
