Hello, Lee-

Just to confirm: the pages you provided still exceed the number beyond the standard response length that we allowed for additional information. Please note that IAC members are not required to read more than the required pages in a submission. Institutions should be sure the relevant information is in the main part of the response, not in the supporting materials.

More importantly, however, the document still contains live links (e.g. links to YouTube videos and board documents). We cannot support live links in these response documents because it interferes with reliable record keeping. It's not clear where links may lead, how long they will persist, when and if changes are made to them, and so on.

Because of these reasons, and for the time being, I have pulled your response for the August IAC. If you are still satisfied with the response you've provided, I will submit it, and your materials will go to the October 3-4, 2022 IAC meeting. If you would instead prefer to provide a different response for consideration at the October meeting, please provide it by August 15.

Please let me know one way or the other. I will be out of the office for the remainder of the week, but will keep an eye out for your email. Thanks.
