These awards are given annually to individuals, organizations and departments that have demonstrated exemplary leadership, vision or service in promoting diversity and inclusion, beyond their normal scope of work, in the following three categories:

The **Leadership Award** is presented to those who have demonstrated leadership in developing initiatives that have enhanced and furthered diversity and inclusion goals.

The **Service Award** is presented to those who have participated in or initiated diversity and inclusion-related work in areas including committees, community involvement and/or community outreach.

The **Education Award** is presented to those who have offered teaching, programming or activities designed to foster or enhance diversity and inclusion.

Award eligibility is open to students, employees, and departments within the College as well as community members and organizations in Pima County. Previous recipients are eligible for nomination every five years. Self-nominations are accepted.

The deadline to submit nominations is Friday, April 5, 2019.






