PURPOSE

The awarding of Chancellor Emeritus status is intended as a special honor for Pima <a href="Community College" College" employees who have served as Chancellor with great distinction. Prior Chancellors receiving such an award exemplify the characteristics of ideal community college educators who, through their professional careers at Pima Community the College, have contributed significantly to the College and to the community it serves. Status is not guaranteed as a matter of due course; it is granted only to those whose service has been exemplary. Recipients of the Chancellor Emeritus distinction will be identified by name and title with the emeritus distinction in the College's catalog and/or in other College publications.

The Chancellor Emeritus designation shall not create any contractual obligation nor shall there be any compensation connected with the title.

<u>Chancellor</u> Emeritus <u>status</u> <u>distinction</u> may be bestowed posthumously.

ELIGIBILITY

Any individual candidate who meets the follow criteria is eligible to be nominated for recommendation for the Chancellor Emeritus distinction who meets the following criteria:

- A minimum of <u>five (5)</u> years of full-time service to <u>Pima Community</u> <u>the</u> College as <u>its</u> Chancellor;
- <u>Has</u> concluded or <u>is</u> in the process of concluding <u>the candidate's</u> <u>his or her</u> service as <u>the College's</u> Chancellor;
- <u>Has</u> established a record of distinguished service <u>to the College and the community</u> while <u>serving employed</u> as Chancellor; and
- <u>Has</u> not been the subject of an adverse personnel decision by the College.

NOMINATION

Any Governing Board member may recommend nominate an eligible candidate for the honorary emeritus Chancellor Emeritus honor title. The Governing Board may confer this title on a nominated candidate by majority vote on an appropriate Governing Board resolution.
