Additional Information:
 (1) Concentrators are limited to those students who first enrolled at PCC as a postsecondary student within the last 5 years and had not received a PCC award as of the start of the program year. (2) Students were included as concentrators only if they met the concentrator requirements within a given occupational program at PCC. Program-level CIP codes were used to map students into Career Clusters. (3) All dual enrollment courses and credits were removed when determining concentrator status. (4) Duplication between clusters was removed by first taking the most recent concentration, then selecting the concentration area in which the student had earned the greatest number of credits, and finally using the program that the student was closest to completing.
