

Student Right to Know Graduation/ Completion & Transfer Rates

July 2017/Cohort of Fall 2013

Pima County Community College District (PCC) provides the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion and transfer rates in compliance with the federal Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008. The rates reflect the graduation and transfer status of students newly enrolled at PCC during fall 2013 and for whom 150 percent of the normal time-to-program completion has elapsed.

In fall 2013, 2,675 first-time, full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered PCC.

After 150 percent completion time had elapsed, 13.9 percent of these students had graduated from PCC and 18.3 percent had transferred to another institution of public higher education. This gives PCC a success rate of 32.1 percent.

Student-athletes Receiving Athletic-Based Financial Aid

During the 2013-2014 year, 96 first-time, full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking undergraduate student-

athletes received athletic-based scholarships while enrolled at PCC. After 150 percent completion time, 19.8 percent of them completed their programs.

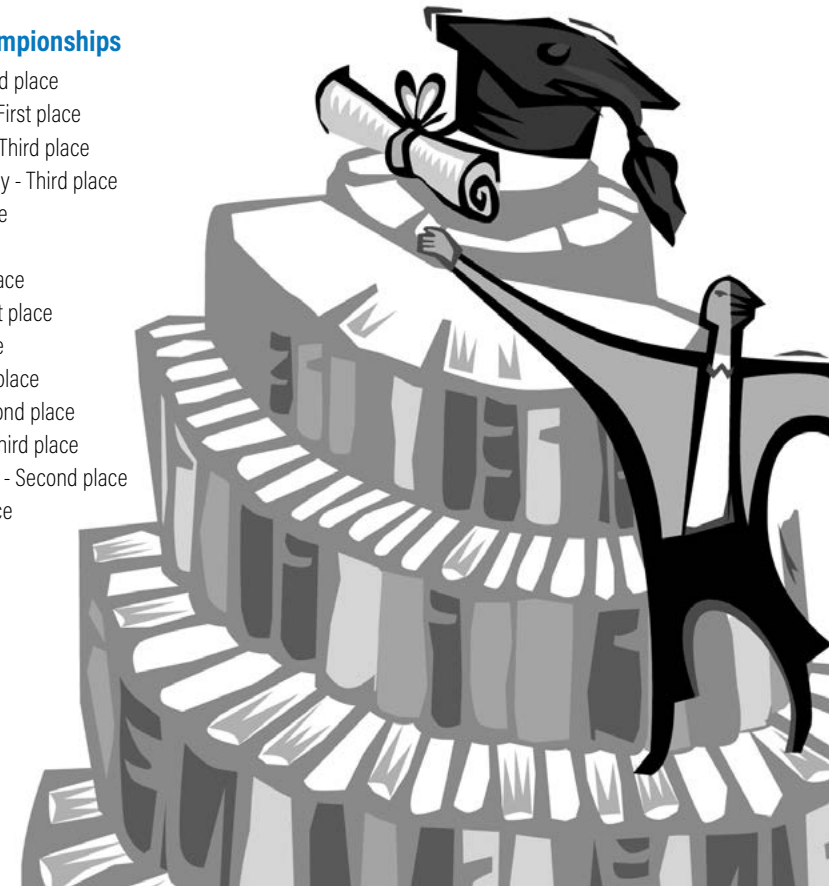
