Certifications
 □ Basic First Aid First Aid classes can be taken through Desert Fire or American Red Cross. (Cannot be online, must be in-person) □ Basic Life Support (BLS)/ CPR (Health care provider). You can obtain this certification by taking a class through Desert Fire or American Red Cross. Classes usually cost between \$80 and \$92. If you are funded by Pima County OneStop, be sure to coordinate with your caseworker, as the cost of the class should be covered. (Cannot be online, must be in-person)
