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# CEP Overview

- Collaboration between Pima Community College and ASU allowing students to complete both their associate degree in nursing (ADN) at their community college and their BSN with ASU simultaneously.
  - **Traditional Start:** Begin ASU coursework the semester before Block I.
  - **Midpoint Start:** Begin ASU coursework upon successful completion of Block I.
- ASU Courses are taught 100% online.
- Flexible plan of study; students can take breaks from the ASU coursework, if needed, in consultation with ASU academic advisor.
- Reduced tuition rate is available. Current tuition rates can be viewed at [students.asu.edu/tuition](http://students.asu.edu/tuition).
  - ASU offers a consortium agreement with Financial Aid and Scholarship Services to help students maximize their financial aid award amounts.

# CEP Eligibility

## Traditional Start

**To be eligible to join the ASU CEP, students must meet the following criteria:**

- ✓ Successfully complete all Pima Community College requirements for ADN admission.
- ✓ Earn a minimum 3.0 ASU prerequisite GPA, which is calculated using the following courses:
  - WRT 101 First Year Composition I
  - WRT 102 First Year Composition II
  - College Mathematics or higher
    - Math course must fulfill ASU's MA or MATH general studies requirement.

\*Although not required for CEP eligibility or admission, students are highly encouraged to complete PCC co-requisites prior to enrolling in the CEP to help with the course load while in the program.

# Steps to Apply

## Traditional Start

### Gather information

Student watches a pre-recorded nursing information session with Pima Nursing.

Student consults with both community college and ASU admission teams about the course requirements for ADN admission and ASU CEP.

### Submit CEP application

Student submits the CEP application on Pima Nursing website when they have completed all of the ASU CEP prerequisites.

### Submit ADN application

Students can choose to submit both a Traditional AAS Nursing application, but it is not required.

### Selection

Check Pima Nursing CEP website for time-to-decision timeline.

# Selection Process

## Traditional Start

### Pima Nursing receives CEP application

Pima Nursing reviews applications for admission after the specified deadline.

### Edson College application review

Applications are shared with ASU Edson College team to verify prerequisite completion/prerequisite GPA.

### Pima Nursing selects students

Pima selects eligible applicants based on rubric system.

Pima notifies students via email of CEP admission or denial.

### Selected students apply to ASU

Admitted students will receive detailed instructions about how to submit the ASU application for admission with their CEP admission email.

# Midpoint Start

Students currently enrolled in Pima's nursing program can begin the ASU CEP coursework after successful completion of block 1 of their associate degree nursing program.

## Enroll in ADN Program

## Connect with ASU

Email unofficial transcripts to [asu.cep@asu.edu](mailto:asu.cep@asu.edu) OR submits a request for information online at [links.asu.edu/cep](http://links.asu.edu/cep).

## ASU verifies eligibility

Share proof of enrollment and unofficial transcripts for review.

## Apply to ASU

Once admitted, student receives a customized Plan of Study and enrolls in ASU courses.

# Welcome Email

Every admitted ASU CEP student is assigned to an Edson College academic advisor.

Your assigned Edson College academic advisor will communicate with you via email with a **Welcome Email**.

The Welcome Email includes what you have been enrolled in (advisors enroll) as well as a full list of required courses needed to graduate with your BSN. You'll use this as a guide to self-enroll in your courses in future semesters.

Schedule an advising appointment with any additional questions after the Welcome Email has been received.

# Online Postlicensure Programs

## RN to BSN

Self-paced and can be completed in 14-24 months.

### Eligibility criteria

- Active RN license in good standing.
- Minimum 2.50 transfer GPA.
- Grade of C or higher in the following prerequisite courses: ENG 101, ENG 102 and an approved college mathematics (MA) course.

## RN to MS Nursing Bridge

Designed for working RNs and can be completed in 24-32 months.

- MS in Nursing.
- MS Nursing Education.

No bachelor's degree required or conferred.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Active RN license in good standing.
- Associate degree in nursing.
- 72 transferable undergraduate credits
- Minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Statistics.
