- 1. Apply for admission at <u>pima.edu/apply</u>. Once you complete your application, you will be given a PCC Student ID number (begins with "A0").
- 2. Activate your MyPima account at <u>mypima.pima.edu</u>. MyPima is the student portal and is the primary communication tool for students and the College.
- 3. Complete and submit the Verification of Lawful Presence Form required by the state of Arizona to prove your U.S. citizenship. \_\_\_\_\_

Students seeking admission to the EMT Program must provide proof of proficiency in reading at the ninth grade level. To determine eligibility, the assigned program advisor will assist you with completing the section below. NOTE: Be prepared to provide your PCC student ID #, phone number and end goal (i.e., EMT, fire, paramedic) to the program advisor.
