Minimum Seats: 12

Estimated Study Abroad Program Fee: \$4,244
Includes round-trip airfare between Tucson and Germany, lodging (shared hotel room), breakfasts, two dinners and all group activities. This does not include transportation to/from Tucson International Airport, Pima tuition, travel insurance, passport fee, some entrance fees, lunches, most dinners, etc.

Other Expenses Not Included in the Program Fee:

Estimated meals not in program fee: \$400

Estimated Comprehensive Travel Insurance: \$100

Public transportation card: \$75
