All,

Recently, several attempted vehicle burglaries, license plate thefts, and vehicle vandalism have occurred at several locations throughout the district. Specifically, West Campus, Downtown Campus, and District Office. These incidents are not believed to be related and are being investigated.

Vehicles with property inside in plain sight are targets for thieves. Secure your valuables out of sight in your vehicle or take them with you, lock your doors, and park as close to the building as possible in well lit areas. Park front-first to discourage license plate theft. Keeping your car clean inside makes it uninteresting to thieves. Having a vehicle alarm is highly recommended and will lower your insurance premiums.
