Attempted Sexual Assault – PCC WEST CAMPUS, 2202 W Anklam Road.

On 06/30/2026 at approximately 11:32 PM, an assault occurred at the bus stop located at Pima Community College West Campus, 2202 W. Anklam Road. The female victim stated that a male suspect physically attacked her and attempted to sexually assault her.

The suspect is described as an unknown male with a medium build, who may have his hair styled in a ponytail. He was last seen wearing a red hooded sweatshirt and dark pants, carrying a white bag, and walking away from the bus stop toward Anklam Road and Greasewood Road.

The Pima College Police Department is actively investigating the incident.

- Trust your instincts. If you sense trouble, get away as soon as possible.
- Remain alert and observe people around you. Walk with your head up, avoid carrying many items, show confidence while walking, and know your destination.
- If possible, have your phone ready and know where you are at all times.
- Call PCCPD at (520) 206-2700 for an escort from a police officer or community service officer.
- Make mental notes of a suspect's race, age, sex, height, weight, hair, and eye color, build, and clothing. Note anything unusual about the suspect, such as scars, tattoos, strange mannerisms, or speech patterns that you can share with police.
