Armed Robbery, Attempted Sexual Assault

On Friday, Jan. 18, 2013 at 6:15 p.m. the Pima Community College Police Department received a call from a female student who reported that she was robbed at gunpoint and the victim of an attempted sexual assault at the Downtown Campus, 1255 N. Stone. The student reported the incident occurred between 4:40 p.m. and 5:40 p.m.

The student reported while in the women's restroom a male exited a stall and ordered her back into the stall at gun point. The student reported that the male subject demanded she turn over some personal property and attempted to sexually assault her.

The student described the male as black, in his 20s with short dreadlocks, about 5'8" to 5'11. She reported he was wearing black jeans, a black and grey plaid long sleeve shirt and black shoes. The male subject was last seen leaving the restroom.

This is an active investigation and updates may follow. Anyone with information regarding this incident is asked to call **9-1-1** or 88- Crime.
