Aggravated Assault on Police Officer

On Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at approximately 4:15 p.m. a Pima Community College Police Officer was approached by a student near the Welcome Desk at the Downtown Campus advising of a white male drinking alcohol and harassing students in the patio area. The officer responded to the patio area near the AH building and located a white male matching the description. The male became combative and started fighting with the officer. The officer gave commands to comply and deployed his Taser striking the male. He was able to take the male into custody without further incident. The male was evaluated by Tucson Fire Department and was cleared by them. The male is a non-student and was arrested for Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer and transported to the Pima County Jail where he was booked.
