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# PCC Releases Truth in Taxation Information

Tucson, AZ – Pima County Community College District has released its Truth in Taxation information for the fiscal year 2015-2016 budget, in compliance with [Arizona Revised Statute 15-1461.01](#).

According to the Truth in Taxation information, the College is proposing an increase in primary tax revenues of \$2,042,257, an increase of 2.0 percent over fiscal year 2014-2015, as allowed by state law. The proposed fiscal year 2016 combined property tax rate of \$1.3689 per \$100 of assessed value will cause Pima County Community College District's primary property taxes on a \$100,000 home to increase from \$134.21 (total taxes that would be owed without the proposed tax increase) to \$136.89 (total proposed taxes including the tax increase). Details concerning the impact of this proposal, as compared to not increasing taxes, are listed in the Truth in Taxation notice published in the Arizona Daily Star on May 22 and June 1, 2015. The College's secondary tax rate is proposed to continue at zero. The College has been completely debt free since July 2014.

The College's publicly elected five-member [Board of Governors](#) will hold a public hearing on the proposed fiscal year 2015-2016 budget, property tax rates and levies on Wednesday, June 10, 2015. The public hearing will begin at 5:00 p.m. in the College's Community/Board Room at the District Office, 4905 E. Broadway Blvd. [Review the College's proposed fiscal year 2016 Budget](#).

A Special Meeting to vote on fiscal year 2015-2016 budget, property tax rates, and levies, follows the public hearing. During the Special Meeting, the Governing Board will consider a motion to levy the increased property tax by a roll call vote. Any increase would take effect on July 1, 2015.
