## New Mexico Resident Undergraduate Tuition Reciprocity Program Application

The New Mexico Higher Education Department and Pima County Community College District have established a tuition reciprocity program agreement. This agreement allows eligible students from New Mexico state to enroll at Pima Community College with authorization to pay Arizona in-state tuition rates<sup>\*</sup>. This agreement also allows eligible students from Pima Community College to enroll at selected institutions in New Mexico with authorization to pay New Mexico in-state tuition rates. **\*New Mexico students are not eligible to establish Arizona residency for in-state tuition purposes until one year after discontinuing participation in the New Mexico Tuition Reciprocity Undergraduate program.**

- Parents' New Mexico federal or state income tax return with New Mexico address for previous year, showing student listed as dependent, or
- Valid New Mexico Voter ID card
