- Human Resources: Carleen Thompson, Assistant Vice Chancellor for HR
 - Training area the following courses are set for completion:
 - Overcoming unconscious bias in the workplace
 - Overcoming your own unconscious bias

 - Classification and Compensation Study
 - Class & Comp Study is on schedule. Summary report from Segal Group expected mid Fall semester.
 - Staff Position Review
 - Once job descriptions are complete, the Segal team will begin to identify survey job matches in published compensation surveys such as CUPA-HR surveys and other general industry surveys. This process will continue through the end of Summer.

 - Segal is developing the methodology for the market assessment. This includes a review of current compensation data and published compensation survey results for identified peer institutions.
 - Once the methodology is finalized and reviewed with PCC's Compensation and Classification team, we will then review and seek input from the Faculty Steering Committee. We anticipate this will be ready over the summer

• IT: Updates - Evan Goldberg - Deputy Chief Information Officer

- Work from anywhere initiative. New standard of laptops with docking stations with multiple monitors for hybrid employees. Needs will be determined at department level.
- O The IT "Team Dynamix" ticketing system (available now at service.pima.edu) is being expanded to include other areas to create other service management systems for employee facing areas.
- O Global microchip shortage is hindering equipment acquisition. 1300 laptops have been delayed until December. Workarounds are being explored.
- o 15 Hyflex classrooms are being developed with high end video conferencing systems. These will accommodate both in person and remote learners at the same time.
- Work ongoing with Centers of Excellence, (Automotive, Aviation, Advanced Manufacturing, Public Safety, and Allied Health) deploying new technology in classrooms, conference areas, and lab areas.
- O Video management software deployed Panopto will allow video editing and storage for use internally and in the classroom.
- O Major project to upgrade fiber optic network between campuses.

Provost's Office:

- Fall planning message from Dr. Dore President of Campuses and Executive Vice Chancellor
 - A message is coming from the Chancellor's office for returning in the Fall next week. CDC has set new guidelines that students and faculty that have been vaccinated, do not need to wear masks.
 - Thanks to everyone for the work done during the pandemic. Requests to work remotely will be considered by individual supervisors. Employees that need special accommodations related to family or medical conditions can contact the employee service center.
 - Plexiglass has been installed in all front facing areas as well as the ongoing installation of Synexis air purifying devices in the classrooms, prioritizing the more confined spaces.
 - Facilities have increased the frequency of the HVAC filter changes.
 - More friendly COVID-19 signage coming.
 - EH&S has distributed classroom cleaning caddies to all campuses.
 - Custodial services have been beefed up.
 - If PPE is needed, that is ready to be distributed.
