Students and Parents will need their own FSA ID. You'll need the following items to create one:

- » Social Security number (use legal name as listed on your card)
- » Your own mobile phone number and/or email address

To receive federal aid you will need to complete the FAFSA and renew it every year on October 1st. **Pima's school code for FAFSA is 007266.** 

# After you complete the FAFSA -Check MyPima

Activate your MyPima student account. All communication from Financial Aid and Scholarships at Pima will be sent to your student account (email, messages, requirements, etc.).

- » Allow 3-5 days for your FAFSA to be received by Pima.
- » Login at *mypima.pima.edu*
- » Go to Students > Financial Aid > Financial Aid
- » Scroll down to the Financial Aid Requirements section and complete any requirements with a red X.

### **ABOUT THE FAFSA**

You'll need the following information to complete a FAFSA:

- » Your Social Security Number
- » Your parent/s' Social Security Number if you're a dependent student
- » Your Alien Registration Number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- » Federal tax information, tax returns, W-2 for you (and your spouse if married), and for your parent/s if you are a dependent student
- Records of untaxed income such as child support received, interest income, veteran noneducation benefits for you and your parent/s (if applicable)
- Information on savings, checking account, investments, business assets for you and for your parent/s (if applicable)
